9. CHANGE CONTROL

9.5.2 Clauses 17.3 (Obligation to Include National Terms of Connection Wording in Contracts), 18.1 (Provision of Use of System), 19.1 and 19.2 (Charges), 24 (Security Cover), 25 (Energisation, De-Energisation and Re-Energisation), 26.1 (Compliance with the Distribution Code), 27.1 (Compliance with MOCOPA), 30.5 to 30.12 (inclusive) (Dangerous Incidents and Advance Notice of Interruptions and Damage or Interference), 31.1 (Demand Control), ~~and~~ 33.1 to 33.2 (inclusive) (Compensation Under Guaranteed Performance Standards), and 35A (Provision of Cost Information);

35A. PROVISION OF COST INFORMATION

35A.1 This Clause 35A shall only apply where the Company is a DNO Party.

35A.2 By the fifth Working Day of January, April, July and October in each year, the Company shall complete a copy of the table in Schedule [XX]¹ and send the completed table to the Secretariat.

35A.3 The Secretariat shall, within three Working Days of receiving each table provided pursuant to this Clause 35A, publish such table on the Website.

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1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this Schedule [XX]³, except where the context otherwise requires, the following terms shall have the meanings set opposite them:

Current Price Control Period means, in respect of any forecast, the then current control period at the time the forecast is made (where a control period is the period by reference to which the Authority revises the price control conditions applicable to DNO Parties, the fourth such period being from 1 April 2005 to 31 March 2010).

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Demand Use of System Charges has the meaning given to that term in the special conditions of the Company’s Distribution Licence.

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Relevant Year has the meaning given to that term in the special conditions of the Company’s Distribution Licence.

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Relevant Year t means, in respect of any forecast, the then current Relevant Year at the time the forecast is made (and **Relevant Year t+1** shall be the following Relevant Year and so on).
