Invalid Settlement Classes

Amend note 2 in paragraph 141 of Schedule 16 (CDCM)

Note 2: ~~Where~~ DNO Parties shall use the 'Domestic Unrestricted' rate as a default tariff for invalid settlement combinations ~~these will be charged at the Domestic Unrestricted rates. For the avoidance of doubt, the DNO Parties should, in accordance with Clause 20 (Billing and Payment by Settlement Class), use the data contained in the Supercustomer DUoS Report to produce the Daily Statement, and should not alter such data to seek to correct the invalid settlement combinations in creating the Daily Statement.~~

Add a note at the end of paragraph 147 of Schedule 16 (CDCM)

Note 1: Where portfolio data contains invalid combinations, the 'LDNO HV: Domestic Unrestricted' fixed and unit charge will be applied as a default. For the avoidance of doubt, the DNO Parties should, in accordance with Schedule 19 (Portfolio Billing), use the data provided to them (as modified in accordance with that Schedule), and should not alter such portfolio data to seek to correct the invalid settlement combinations.
