

DCP 176 'Housekeeping change for Disconnection definition' Legal Drafting

Option 1

Disconnect means:

(a) in respect of Section 2A, to permanently disconnect a Metering Point or Metering System by the removal of all or part of the Company's equipment associated with the connection of such Metering Point or Metering System; or

(b) in respect of Section 2B, to permanently ~~De-energise~~ disconnect a Connection Point by the removal of all or part of the Company's Connection Equipment and Connection Assets.

Option 2

Disconnect means:

(a) in respect of Section 2A, to permanently ~~disconnect~~ De-energise a Metering Point or Metering System by the removal of all or part of the Company's equipment associated with the connection of such Metering Point or Metering System; or

(b) in respect of Section 2B, to permanently De-energise a Connection Point by the removal of all or part of the Company's Connection Equipment and Connection Assets.
