<b>Synopsis</b>	This paper presents a Change Proposal that has been submitted to the DCUSA Secretariat and requests agreement on its progression.

## 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This paper refers a DCUSA Change Proposal (DCP) to the DCUSA Panel for agreement on its progression.
- 1.2 The Change Proposal (CP) has been assessed by the Secretariat in accordance with Section 10.11 of the DCUSA. The CP has met the requirements set out in the DCUSA and ElectraLink has prepared a recommendation for consideration by the Panel.

## 2 DCP 049 – HOUSEKEEPING AMENDMENT TO SCHEDULE 14.

- 2.1 DCP 050 has been raised by E.ON UK and seeks an amendment to Schedule 14. DCP 035 was implemented in February 2009 to introduce consequential changes arising as a result of the Distribution and Supply Licence Review. One such amendment was to replace references to “energywatch” with the “National Consumer Council”. E.ON UK has identified an error in the drafting of Schedule 14 which references the “consumer council” rather than the “National Consumer Council.”
- 2.2 The originator considers that the Change Proposal will better facilitate DCUSA Objective 4<sup>1</sup>.

## 3 PROGRESSION OF DCP 049

- 3.1 DCP 049 has been submitted as a standard Change Proposal. It is proposed that the Change Proposal go straight to Report phase in accordance with Clause 11.6 of the DCUSA as it is a minor housekeeping amendment.
- 3.2 The CP does not impact any Part 1 matters and is therefore considered as a Part 2 issue and does not require Authority Consent.
- 3.3 It is proposed that this CP should be implemented in the November 2009 Release.
- 3.4 A proposed timetable for the progression of the proposal is outlined below:
