

The following update was given by an MRA representative:-

At MDB on 30th October a number of changes were agreed to be sent for Impact Assessment including the following:

- **MAP CP 0217 - Amending MAP 15 to limit users to a defined number of searches within ECOES**
- **MAP CP 0218 - Updating MAP22 Extract Examples for the transfer of customer information between DNO's and Suppliers**
- **DTC CP 3449 - Amending the Unique Reference within the D0352 (Disconnections Data Flow) to be Mandatory**
- **DTC CP 3449 - Amending the Unique Reference within the D0352 Data Flow to Mandatory**

On 6th November 2014 DTC v11.1 was released to live and subsequently DTC v11.2 (26th February 2015) Pre-release has been issued which includes changes for EMR invoicing.

IREG met on 12th November 2014 and covered SPF 0084 Service Termination Point Collection Information. ENA have agreed to set a session up between themselves, Suppliers and Meter Operators to bottom out the definition of data to be collected and the way in which that data can be selected through any hand held device the operative on site has with them. MIF 158 – Populating ASC information. Parties agreed that the preference would be to utilise MPRS to populate the information and send to Suppliers. The preference currently is to use the D0171 (Notification of Distributor Changes to Metering Point Details) although an alternate may be via the D0215 (Provision of Site Technical Details).

On 6th November 2014 GDCC Release 7.0 was issued to Live. A number of housekeeping changes have been agreed by MDB to the GDCC Access Agreement and now await Secretary of State consent. These amendments have been put in place since the original Access Agreements signed by Suppliers, Distributors and Green Deal Providers have a two year initial period and will need re-signing by all parties for a further two year period commencing 14th January 2015. Plans are in place to issue these those companies starting early December.
