

### **Proposed Legal Text**

Amend Paragraph 8.5 of DCUSA Schedule 25 as follows and amend reference in paragraph 8.3 of Schedule 25 from 8.5 to 8.5A:

#### 8.5 For the purposes of paragraph 8.5A:

- (a) a Supplier Party shall be an "Applicable Domestic Supplier Party" with effect from 3 months after the date when it is first registered for at least [5,000] domestic gas and electricity Metering Points; and
- (b) a Supplier Party shall be an "Applicable Non Domestic Supplier Party" with effect from 3 months after the date when it is first registered for at least 1 non domestic gas or electricity Metering Point; and
- (c) once a Supplier Party becomes an Applicable Domestic Supplier Party for the purposes of paragraph 8.5 (a), they shall not cease to be an Applicable Domestic Supplier Party for so long as they are Registered for any domestic gas or electricity Metering Points; and
- (d) once a Supplier Party becomes an Applicable Non Domestic Supplier Party for the purposes of paragraph 8.5 (b), they shall not cease to be an Applicable Non Domestic Supplier Party for so long as they are Registered for any non domestic gas or electricity Metering Points.

8.5A By 17.00 hours on the 5<sup>th</sup> Working Day after the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of each calendar month: ~~starting with November 2015, each Supplier Party shall provide to the TRAS Service Provider:~~

- (a) each Applicable Domestic Supplier Party shall provide to the TRAS Service Provider the Supplier Party's Consumption File populated with the data for all the domestic Metering Points for which it is Registered as at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month (to be provided via the secure STS service agreed between that Supplier Party and the TRAS Service Provider); and
- (b) each Applicable Domestic Supplier Party shall provide to the TRAS Service Provider the Supplier Party's updates to the data in the Outcome File relating to domestic Metering Points populated with updates to the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month (to either be provided via the secure STS service agreed

between that Supplier Party and the TRAS Service Provider, or via the system provided for that purpose by the TRAS Service Provider); ~~and-~~

- (c) each Applicable Non Domestic Supplier Party shall provide to the TRAS Service Provider the Supplier Party's Consumption File populated with the data for all the non domestic Metering Points for which it is Registered as at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month (to be provided via the secure STS service agreed between that Supplier Party and the TRAS Service Provider); and
  - (d) each Applicable Non Domestic Supplier Party shall provide to the TRAS Service Provider the Supplier Party's updates to the data in the Outcome File relating to non domestic Metering Points populated with updates to the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the month (to either be provided via the secure STS service agreed between that Supplier Party and the TRAS Service Provider, or via the system provided for that purpose by the TRAS Service Provider).
