

DCP 237 Draft Legal Text

Housekeeping change to Prescribed Period

In Clause 1 (Definitions):

ESPR means the Electricity (Standards of Performance) Regulations 20105 (SI 20105/6989).

Prescribed Period means:
(a) in respect of each of relevant activities described in Clause 30.5A or 30.5B, the period for performance of that activity set out in Part 1 of Schedule 24; or
(b) in respect of Clause 33.5 or 33.6, 'prescribed period' as defined in regulation 3 of the ESPR.

~~**Prescribed Period** has the meaning given to that term in regulation 3 of the ESPR.~~

Working Hours has the meaning given to that term in the ~~ESPR~~Electricity (Standards of Performance) Regulations 2010.

In Clause 33 (Guaranteed Performance Standards):

In Clause 33.4: replace the words "regulation 3(4)(d)" with the words "regulation 3(2)(d)".

In In Clause 33.7: replace the words "regulation 21(5)" with the words "regulation 19(5)".

In In Clause 33.9: replace the words "regulation 20" with the words "regulation 18"; and the words "schedule 2" with "schedule 3".

In Clause 49 (Guaranteed Performance Standards):

In Clause 49.1: replace the words "regulations 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 or 14" with the words "regulations 5, 6, 7, 8, 10 or 12".

In Clause 49.7: replace the words "regulation 21" with the words "regulation 19".

In In Clause 49.9: replace the words "regulation 20" with the words "regulation 18"; and the words "schedule 2" with "schedule 3".

Amend Schedule 16 (CDCM), Paragraph 175:

175. The majority of customers are compensated under the Guaranteed Standards arrangements set out in the Electricity (Standards of Performance) Regulations 201~~5~~0.

Amend Schedule 22 (CCCM), Section 2 (Glossary):

Guaranteed Standards of Performance

standards of service backed by a guarantee and set out in the Electricity (Standards or Performance) Regulations 200~~1~~5 ~~(as amended)~~.
