ACTION 04/07

See what general information can be made available regarding the pricing for providing the D2021 flow service and any other points made throughout the responses that Parties have highlighted.

ACTION 05/01

Clarify internally, what the process is with regard to the UK Power Distribution's response to Question 12. Specifically, if the D2021 and D2026 products are a combined offering or whether you can have one and not the other.

ElectraLink's commercial business confirmed that users are able to use any combination of the D2021 and D2026 flows once they are onboarded onto the service. Both D2021 and D2026 products are included in the service.

ACTION 05/03

Obtain information internally regarding the governance arrangements currently used or that could be used. [Relates to the internal governance/change process ElectraLink runs to keep the D2021/D2026 flows up-to-date]

The current governance is determined by a change processes between ElectraLink Ltd. and Users. If there is a request to change technical flow structure of the DUoS e-billing service, it will have to be agreed by all DUoS e-billing users.

ACTION 05/07

Ask internally to confirm if there is a belief that 6 months is a sufficient enough timeframe for both ElectraLink and Parties to implement systems and complete contract negotiation with a number of Parties at the same time.

Although ElectraLink are able to onboard multiple operational services within this timeframe it is our experience that the contract acceptance process for individual parties can take longer than this.
