

**Amend the text for ‘Category B Situation’ in the definitions section, as below:**

**Category A Situation** means a situation in which the Company’s Electric Lines or Electrical Plant does (or is likely to) pose a danger, including danger of death of or injury to persons and/or danger of damage to or destruction of property.

**Category B Situation** means a situation in which the condition of the Company’s Electric Lines or Electrical Plant prevents metering work from being carried out or prevents a meter from being exchanged ~~but where the situation is no a Category A Situation~~ or where a Category A Situation has been made safe.
