Welcomes and Apologies

The Chairman noted the welcomes and apologies for this meeting.

Administration

- 1.1 The Working Group reviewed the “Competition Law Do’s and Don’ts”. All Working Group members agreed to be bound by the Competition Laws Do’s and Don’ts for the duration of the meeting.
- 1.2 The Working Group reviewed the minutes of the last meeting and approved the minutes with a few minor amendments as a fair and accurate representation of the discussions held.

2. Review of the DCP 282 Draft Legal Text

- 2.1 The Working Group walked through the DCP 282 draft legal text which acts as Attachment 1.
- 2.2 The Working Group noted that the addition of an EDNO definition and the proposed new Clause 46A.2.2 may have a consequential impact on DCP 251¹/252². The secretariat agreed to raise it for discussion under the DCP 251/252 Working Group.

ACTION 04/01: ElectraLink agreed to raise the legal text crossovers identified for discussion under the DCP 251/252 Working Group.

- 2.3 The Working Group amended the spelling of the definition ‘*Unmetered Supplies Certificate*’ to ‘*Unmetered Supply Certificate*’ to align with the BSC. It was agreed to query with the legal advisor whether the definition of ‘*Market Participant Identifier*’ through reference to this definition in the BSC should be added to the National Terms of Connection (NTC). Also whether the definition of UMSO as related to the BSC should be defined within the NTC.
- 2.4 Members discussed the meaning of ‘Items’ as a piece of equipment on the network to which the agreement or charging code applies and ‘items’ in the context of the legal text. The Working Group agreed to check with the DCUSA legal advisor “*Do we need both Item or items with consideration made to the definition of election?*”
- 2.5 Embedded Network is not a defined term in the NTC. The Working Group considered that EDNO Distribution System is a defined term and should be used and agreed to seek clarification from the DCUSA legal advisor on this point.

- 2.6 Members amended the Clause 7.1 of the legal text to make it clear that a single consolidated inventory should be provided to the DNO and EDNO.

ACTION 04/02: ElectraLink agreed to raise the legal text clarifications with the DCUSA legal advisor.

3. Review of the DCP 282 Draft Change Report

- 3.1 On review of the change report, it was noted that under the Working Group response to consultation question one that members considered that double counting occurred less frequently than no counting and being settled on the wrong Party's MPAN. It was agreed to reference these multiple settlement inaccuracies in the change report.
- 3.2 The Working Group agreed to amend the change report to:
- Replace 'UMS Customers' with 'unmetered customers' and uncapitalise;
 - Update the Clauses impacted by this change based on the updated legal text;
 - Add the high level views of Ofgem and Elexon on the ENWL trial;
 - Add benefits from the CP form to paragraph 1.3 of the change report;
 - Add further text on the consultation question on the provision of a Service Level Agreement (SLA) between the EDNO and the DNO;
 - Add a sample of respondents consulted from the consultation distribution list;
 - Add text on the Working Groups agreed inter-distributor billing process to the consultation responses summary section of the change report; and
 - Add text on the changes to Section 2A and the housekeeping amendment to the draft legal text section of the change report.

ACTION 04/02: ElectraLink agreed to amend the change report accordingly.

ACTION 04/03: DT agreed to provide wording on the SVV decision on BSC CP 1414 'Combining LDSO and Embedded LDSOs UMS Inventories on to single LDSO MSID' (include wording on the number of customers consulted) and on the reason for the withdrawal of DCP 168 'The Administration of Use of System charges relating to connections from Embedded Distribution Network Operator (EDNO) systems to Unmetered Supplies (UMS) for LA customers to paragraph 3.3 of the change report.

ACTION 04/04: The secretariat agreed to provide wording on the materiality of DCP 203 and its outcome to paragraph 3.3 of the consultation.

ACTION 04/05: DT agreed to provide wording on why the D0314 is not affected under paragraph 4.6

ACTION 04/06: Under Consumer impacts DT agreed to provide text on the benefits for UMS customers
