

DCP210 – The Assessment Timetable

In order to determine the best approach to the assessment timetable a number of options have been identified for review by the working group together with the timescales associated with similar industry code documents.

Options

- Amend the number of Working Days in general or specific to each type of change; or
- Leave the timetable to the Panel and let them develop a process to determine what that timetable should be; or
- The Panel request a timetable from the working group first meeting as part of a revised terms of reference

Administration timetable of the codes other than Authority determined timescales, urgent change proposals or those going straight to a Change Report stage.
