

Proposed legal text

30. Provision of information

Elective HH Metering arrangements

- 30.18 Where Metering Points are on Elective HH Metered arrangements the User shall provide an equivalent tariff for each Metering Point in line with Schedule 16, Paragraph 147, table 4, four months in advance of the [1st April 2013] in order that the Company can meet the requirements of Schedule 16, Paragraph 72.
- 30.19 The User shall provide an update of the information provided under Clause 30.18 for Metering Points on Elective HH Metered arrangements as at the [31st March 2013] within 5 Working Days of this date.
- 30.20 On receiving notification under Clause 30.19 the Company shall amend the tariffs of the Metering Points with an effective date of the [1st April 2013].
- 30.21 Where a Metering Point is changed to an Elective HH Metered arrangement on or after the [1st April 2013] the User shall notify the Company of the tariff selected from the Company's Relevant Charging Statement that the Metering Point shall be assigned to within 5 Working Days of such a change.
- 30.22 On receiving notification under Clause 30.21 the Company shall amend the tariff of the Metering Point so that the effective date of the change to an Elective HH Metered arrangement and that of the tariff is one and the same.
- 30.23 Where no notification is received under Clause 30.18, Clause 30.19 or Clause 30.21 the Company may apply:
- 30.23.1 the most appropriate tariff based on the Company's assessment; or
 - 30.23.2 apply a default tariff equivalent to that of a Domestic Unrestricted tariff.
- 30.24 Where a Metering Point is already on an Elective HH Metered arrangement on or after the [1st April 2013] the User shall notify the Company of an alternative tariff selected from the Company's Relevant Charging Statement that the Metering Point shall be assigned to.

30.25 On receiving notification under Clause 30.24 the Company shall apply the alternative tariff [within 5 Working Days of the request or from the 1st of the following month].
