

DCP 164: Proposed Amendments to DCUSA

Add the following text to the DCUSA Definitions (Section 1A):

Pre-release Model A model made available by the DCUSA Panel prior to a published model, which incorporates approved changes not yet implemented

Add the following text to DCUSA Section 1C:

Change Proposals Affecting Schedule 16, Schedule 17, and Schedule 18 Models and Model Inputs

- 14.10 Change Proposals with Authority approval 90 days prior to the minimum notice period for the publication of charges (as defined in the Distribution Licence) and an Implementation Date of the following April will be included in the model(s) released to apply for that April. Any Change Proposals that receive Authority approval less than 90 days prior to the publication of charges will not be included in the model(s) released to calculate charges to apply from the following April.
- 14.11 DNO Parties will use the pre-release model(s) that is available a minimum of 50 days prior to the publication of charges, as provided by the DCUSA Panel.
- 14.12 Changes that affect the methodology, but not the Charging Models, cannot be implemented without 90 days notice and the implementation date on any change reports submitted to the DCUSA panel after the 90 days notice will be amended to the next
