The CP seeks to update the derogation clause to ensure that derogations are sought in respect of new or altered obligations in a timely fashion and not after realisation of an ongoing non compliance.

Business Justification and Market Benefits

Clause 56 of the DCUSA, relates to the derogation process. It is the Panel's view that this normally relates to a Party's ability to comply with a newly implemented CPs. Therefore, Parties should not apply for a derogation some years after the implementation of a CP having realised they are non-compliant.

Proposed Solution and Draft Legal Text

"The Panel may (subject to Clause 56.3) resolve, on the application of any Party, to grant a derogation to any Party or Parties in relation to any obligation or obligations contained in this Agreement. Such derogations will normally be considered in respect of new or altered obligations. In resolving to grant such derogation, the Panel may impose such conditions as it sees fit, and shall specify the term, scope and application of such derogation."
