### **1 ID**

- The DNO should provide a DNO specific Identifier for each revenue request

e.g. LPN1, MIDE1

### **2 Reason for Revenue Change**

- The Network Operator should provide a 1 or 2 line descriptor on the reason for the request - or mark the reason as confidential if necessary

**3 Provide dependencies (if any) on other requests and their reference numbers**

- The Network Operator should provide details of any dependencies between revenue requests:

e.g. If [ID\_1] is not accepted by the Authority, [ID\_3] is an alternate request

ID\_3 is related to ID\_1 and if request is granted, both will apply

No dependency

**4 Monetary Value (£) requested by the Network Operator to the Authority**

- The Network Operator should provide monetary details of the revenue request to the Authority. If more than one option is provided, monetary value details of each scenario should be included here.

**5 Implementation date requested by the Network Operator to the Authority**

- Provide the date requested for implementation of the request

**6 Requested timescales over which the revenue change will be implemented and reported, with details of phasing as appropriate**

- If the Network Operator has requested the revenue change to be phased, provide details of how this will be phased

e.g. £20m additional revenue, phased 2012/13 £14m, 2023/14 £6m

**7 Is this already included in published tariffs or the forecast reporting, DCP 066A, and if so, to what extent/phasing?**

- The Network Operator should provide details on how this request is currently being reported in published tariffs, forecast reporting, DCP066A (including phasing)

**8 Status**

- The Network Operator should provide updates on changes to status

e.g. Under discussion with Ofgem, Approved, Rejected, No Longer Applicable – and any additional information as required
