1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 This document is issued in accordance with Clause 11.20 of the DCUSA. The Change Report details DCP 049 - Housekeeping Amendments to DCUSA Schedule 14.
- 1.2 The voting process for the proposed variation and the timetable of the progression of the CP through the DCUSA Change Control Process is set out in this document.
- 1.3 Parties are invited to consider the proposed amendment attached as Appendix A and submit votes using the form attached as Appendix B to dcusa@electralink.co.uk by 15 October 2009.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 DCP 049 was considered by the DCUSA Panel at its meeting on 16 September 2009. The Panel determined that the CP is a non-urgent Part 2 change and recommended its progression directly to the Report Phase in accordance with Clause 11.6 of the DCUSA as it is a minor housekeeping amendment.

3 DCP 048 - HOUSEKEEPING AMENDMENTS TO THE DCUSA SCHEDULE 14

- 3.1 DCP 050 has been raised by E.ON UK and seeks an amendment to Schedule 14. DCP 035 was implemented in February 2009 to introduce consequential changes arising as a result of the Distribution and Supply Licence Review. One such amendment was to replace references to "energywatch" with the "National Consumer Council". E.ON UK has identified an error in the drafting of Schedule 14 which references the "consumer council" rather than the "National Consumer Council."
- 3.2 The Change Proposal will better facilitate DCUSA Objective 4¹ by ensuring that the DCUSA is accurate and up to date.

4 PROPOSED AMENDMENT AND LEGAL DRAFTING

- 4.1 The proposed legal drafting of DCP 048 has been reviewed by Wragge and Co and is set out in Appendix A.

5 IMPLEMENTATION

- 5.1 If approved, DCP 048 will be implemented in the November 2009

6 PANEL RECOMMENDATION

- 6.1 The Panel considers that DCP 048 will better facilitate DCUSA Objective 4 by ensuring that the DCUSA is accurate and up to date. It has recommended that the Change Proposal be issued to all Parties for a 10 Working Day voting period.
