			<p>confidential as the ability for other parties to see this information did not exist at the time.</p> <p>We also believe that should access to DCUSA information be granted to an IIP, that they should not be able to make any financial gain from having access to this information, and that this should be clearly stated in the drafting.</p> <p>Lastly we do not believe that this change better facilitates any of the DCUSA objectives and in fact may be detrimental to objective 4, " The promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of this Agreement." as it imposes extra cost onto parties for no benefit.</p>
