

A: Not at the moment. Industry are continuing to follow due process and develop the changes at the same timescales but this is always under review.

Q: The DCP359 Change Proposal has progressed alongside the CMP334 mod – how are responses to the consultation going to be reviewed?

A: The Code Administrators are considering prioritising the review to cover areas that require consistency between codes and then code specific aspects thereafter

Q: Within the Change Proposal, Interconnectors are excluded from Final Demand. Is there a difference with how EU and non-EU Interconnectors are treated and would it apply for both distribution and transmission?

Q: Is there expected to be a delay in implementation due to the current pandemic?

DCP 359 'Ofgem Targeted Charging Review Implementation: Customers – who should pay?'

A: Interconnectors are covered by Final Demand in Sch17 and 18. Suggest your concern over double charging is raised within your response so that the Working Group can review in more detail.

A: Q5 relates to the definition of Final Demand Site within it's own rights. Q6 relates to whether there should be some criteria around the definition.

Q: Q5 and Q6 of the consultation seem to be the same, are they asking the same thing?
