Northern Powergrid (Northeast) plc/Northern Powergrid (Yorkshire) plc	Reject	Reject	Objective 4	<p>We are rejecting this Change Proposal on technical/drafting points in respect of actual processes, as we would require much more clarity surrounding the exact purpose of the wording change in Section 12 before we could accept this change. The new paragraph inserted in Section 12 – ‘Collection and Retention of Evidence’ causes us concerns:</p> <p>Obligation, ‘The Distributor shall contact the occupier (and the owner if the owner is not the occupier) of the Premises to register their MPAN with a Supplier and continue to contact the occupier and/or owner until the Premises is registered or disconnected’.</p> <p>The wording would require us to contact both the occupier and the owner (in parallel) however in practice we would only need to contact the owner if we had exhausted all other routes to register an MPAN at the Premises or if there was no occupier.</p> <p>In addition, we are also unclear as to why the above paragraph has been placed in Section 12 when this is likely to take place at the end of an investigation. We feel that a better fit, once its purpose has been clarified, would be to place this in Section 15 – ‘Outcome of Investigation’.</p>
