				<p>With obligations relating to the Electricity Theft Incentive Scheme (ETDIS) transferring from DCUSA Schedule 30 to the REC Theft Reduction Schedule on 01 April 2021 there is an issue in that parties may act in good faith adhering to the DCUSA obligations, providing details of Confirmed Thefts identified in February and March 2021, and these Confirmed Thefts may not be deemed eligible for the ETDIS Scheme Year when the Scheme ends and is discharged by RECCo.</p> <p>We agree that this Change Proposal is positive for DCUSA General Objective 4 'The promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the DCUSA' given the benefits of amending Schedule 30 to correct the difference in dates between the DCUSA and the most recent REC drafting and to also make the necessary amendments to the Confirmed Theft Targets and the Scheme pot value as well as updating the Appendix which contains the reporting timescales for Scheme Year 3 (SY3) and Scheme Year 4 (SY4). This will facilitate transition of ETDIS from the DCUSA to the REC as of 01 April 2021.</p>
