

Review of Paragraph 6 (Exceeded Curtailment Price) of Draft Legal Text

DP Feedback:

I confirm that I've read each para in detail and I'm happy that the use/flow of the terms is correctly and consistently written and reflects the WG's intent in the interpretation of Ofgem's requirements. It's not an easy read (more Umberto Eco than Dick Francis!), but that seems unavoidable for the complex subject matter.

Minor formatting observation (that I understand fully why it's there, as Word took on a mind of its own when I tried to resolve): the bullet points in 6.9 are currently (a) (a) (b).

GM Feedback:

- Paragraphs 6.1 and 6.2 seem to be saying essentially the same thing. Is 6.2 meant to be a clarification of what the Exceeded Import Curtailment Price and Exceeded Export Curtailment Price actually are?
- Missing a full stop at the end of 6.10

The first point is mainly about readability, the second is typographical.
