## 1. Administration

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- 1.1 The Stakeholder Group reviewed the “Competition Law Guidance” and “Terms of Reference”. All Stakeholder Group members agreed to be bound by the Competition Law Guidance for the duration of the meeting and agreed to the Terms of Reference
- 1.2 The actions from this Stakeholder Group have been captured in an action log. The action log can be found at [appendix 1](#).

## 2. Purpose of the Meeting / Timeline for Delivery

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- 2.1 The Chair explained that the purpose of this meeting is to review and discuss the MHHS Programme consequential changes and review the change plan.
- 2.2 The Chair agreed that at the next Panel and Board meeting, a request to only send final agendas rather than both draft and final agendas will be raised. This was to avoid any confusion due to the meetings now being schedule weekly resulting in a draft and final agenda being issued on the same day for two separate meetings.

## 3. Review of Transitional change document

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- 3.1 JL began to take the Stakeholder Group through the latest round of changes that were agreed at the last DCUSA MHHS Stakeholder Group Meeting. A summary of these changes can be found within **Attachment 1 MHHS Transition document 15.3**.
- 3.2 JL highlighted that the changes had also been updated to reflect the latest DCUSA released. JL also stated that there we’re no impacts to any of the MHHS consequential changes within the latest released version of the DCUSA.
  - no amendments required due to DCP422 introduced into DCUSA v15.3 but the version number of the MHHS Transitional change document amended to reflect it is changes against the current version of DCUSA;
  - amended the definition of Data Services Agent to include the Market-Wide Data Service;
  - added the following definitions:
    - Market-Wide Data Service;
    - Market Participant I.D.
  - Removed the amendment to limit the definition to D0242 made in Settlement Class MSiD Count and Settlement Class Unit Count;
  - amended clause 15.5 to refer to market Participant I.D. rather than the DIP I.D.;
  - clause 16 removed. The DIP forms part of the BSC so no need to reflect it separately like the data transfer service since BSC is already catered for in the clause;
  - clause 37 removed. The DIP forms part of the BSC so no need to reflect it separately like the data transfer service since BSC is already catered for in the clause;
  - amended clause 42.14 3 (B) to refer to market Participant I.D. rather than the DIP I.D.;

- Demand Control schedule has been checked and corresponds to previously developed text.
- Market Participant I.D. added to schedule 11;
- Amended schedule 16, paragraph 133 and 140B to cater for the two flows provided by the Market-wide Data Service (IF-013 and IF-014);
- Amended schedule 19 to refer to market Participant I.D.; and
- Amended schedule 21 to refer to market Participant I.D
- Removed the definition of Interface Code of Connection;
- Amended clause 59.3 by deleting “or the DIP Interface Code of Connection” and adding at the end of the paragraph “or for the DIP, in accordance with the provisions of the BSC”.
- Amended clause 59.5 by replacing “DIP Interface Code of Connection” with “BSC”

- 3.3 In regards to the change relating to “Market Participant I.D. added to schedule 11”, it was queried why there were 2 rows in the table.
- 3.4 It was explained this was because some suppliers may have more than 1 MPID so the second row was for illustrative purposes to show you can put more than 1 row within the table to capture additional MPIDs.
- 3.5 It was also noted that CR 19 had been pushed out to the 04 October release . Due to this the REP flow number had been put in square brackets within the draft DCUSA text to highlight that this will need a sense check on release to confirm that the flow IDs haven’t changed.
- 3.6 This was also the case for CR 27.
- 3.7 It was noted that the latest legal text changes had been shared with the Stakeholder Group and can be found in **Attachment 2 MHHS Transition 15.3 of DCUSA**.
- 3.8 It was stated that with the exception of waiting for CR19 and C27 being released the all the changes and been agreed.
- 3.9 JL informed the Stakeholder Group that the release timetable of the programme will be shared with the DCUSA Panel on Wednesday 16 August and then there was a 1-2-1 meeting with the MHHS programme to walk through the timetable Thursday 17 August.
- 3.10 It was agreed to leave the next Stakeholder Group meeting in calendars so that an update post the DCUSA Panel meeting on 16 August 2023 could be provided.
