1. Administration

- 1.1 The Stakeholder Group reviewed the “Competition Law Guidance” and “Terms of Reference”. All Stakeholder Group members agreed to be bound by the Competition Law Guidance for the duration of the meeting and agreed to the Terms of Reference
- 1.2 The actions from this Stakeholder Group have been captured in an action log. The action log can be found at [appendix 1](#).

2. Purpose of the Meeting / Timeline for Delivery

- 2.1 The Chair explained that the purpose of this meeting is to review and discuss the feedback from the legal review on the MHHS legal text and agree next steps.
- 2.2 The updated draft legal text can be found within Attachment 1 DCUSA MHHS Mop-up 2 consultation draft.

3. Review MHHS DCUSA development plan timeline.

- 3.1 JL began to take the Stakeholder Group through the amendments made to the legal text post the review from legal advisors.
- 3.2 The first amendment was to update the definition of Advance Data Service Agent to just ‘Advanced Data Service’ to align with the definitions within Section X-1.
- 3.3 It was noted that the legal text had also been reviewed to update any past reference of Advance Data Service Agent to state just Advance Data Service.
- 3.4 A small amendment to the Daily Statement was made to introduce sub paragraphs to make the definition easier to follow and to distinguish between HH and NHHS.
- 3.5 A slight change to the Data Integration Platform had been made due to the on-going issue 101. The Stakeholder Group had no questions on this amendment.
- 3.6 The above also applied for an amendment to the DIP Supplement definition.
- 3.7 The Smart Data Service Agent Definition was updated to Smart Data Service and the rest of the legal text had been updated to reflect the updated definition.
- 3.8 The Supercustomer DUoS Report definition was updated to reflect that the DIP flow is REP-002B to align with the BSCP.
- 3.9 Reference to the Retail Energy Code was also removed from the Supercustomer DUoS Report definition and replaced with Energy Market Specification.
- 3.10 Unmetered Supplies Procedure had some superfluous text removed as per the legal text review.
- 3.11 Clause 59.3 was updated to make the paragraph generic to both the DTN and DIP.
- 3.12 Clause 59.4 was updated to include the DIP so both DTN and DIP were covered.
- 3.13 Clause 59.5 was also updated to include a reference to the DIP.
- 3.14 Clauses 132 and 143 were updated to move the new draft text to earlier in the paragraph as per the advice from the legal text review.
- 3.15 The BSC Modification P432 definition within clause 183 was updated to state the implementation date of P432 rather than the approval date.

- 3.16 The Working Group then check the amendments alongside the feedback from the legal advisors at Gowlings and confirmed that all the feedback had been captured from the legal review and that the text had been updated appropriately.
- 3.17 The legal advisors feedback can be found within Attachment 2 MHHS Programme - DCUSA legal text amendments Legal Review.
- 3.18 That concluded the review of the legal text.

4. A.O.B

- 4.1 JL advised that he had received an email from the Retail Energy Code asking if DCUSA Parties wanted to mandate any testing by the MHHS Programme for the delivery of the new REP-900 and REP 901 DIP flows as part of CR 17 and CR 29 respectively.
- 4.2 JL highlighted that if a change had been delivered via the BAU DCUSA change process introducing two new data flows, the process usually wouldn't insist on any testing and just request parties complied with the new relevant code once it was implemented.
- 4.3 PW advised that he believed this was already covered by the SIT testing process as the DNOs will sending these flows, not just receiving them.
- 4.4 PW advised he would investigate the testing requirement as the Stakeholder Group were unsure where the testing request needed to be confirmed into.
- 4.5 It was agreed that regular DCUSA MHHS Stakeholder Group meetings were not needed at this time.
