## Withdrawal Notice

### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 This paper provides notification to the DCUSA Panel that, in accordance with Clause 54.5, one Party has submitted notification of their intent to withdraw their Accession to the DCUSA.

### 2. Assessment

- 2.1 On 01 February 2024, the Secretariat received notification from Shell Energy Supply UK Ltd that the business had in fact been Dissolved as of 22 December 2023 and that Ofgem had also revoked their Electricity Supply Licence effective from 08 January 2022.
