Withdrawal Notice

1. Introduction

- 1.1 This paper provides notification to the DCUSA Panel that, in accordance with Clause 54.5, one Party has submitted notification of their intent to withdraw their Accession to the DCUSA.

2. Assessment

- 2.1 On 13 March 2024, the Secretariat received notification from Eco Green Management Limited that they were in the process of transferring their electricity supply licence to E E Solutions Limited, and that novation applications for Eco Green Management Limited's Code obligations were in the process of being progressed accordingly.
- 2.2 The Secretariat further notes that Ofgem proposes to grant consent for the transfer of this Electricity Supply Licence, effective from 01 April 2024. The links to the relevant item on Ofgem's website can be located below:

- 2.4 There are no outstanding DCUSA charges owed by Eco Green Management Limited and nor is Eco Green Management Limited a registered Shareholder.
