1. Administration

Competition Law Guidance

Legal Text Review

- 3.1 The group reviewed the spreadsheet and agreed the following outcomes:

Item	Outcome
CD6-132	Amendment made to the legal drafting to specify ‘non-MHHS Metering Points’.
CD6-152	“s” added to the end of premise.
CD6-326	No change made – noted that the incorrect document may have been reviewed and the suggested change was already in the latest draft legal text.
CD6-327	No change made – noted that the incorrect document may have been reviewed and the passage of time meant the suggested change was no longer required.
CD6-328	No change made – noted that the incorrect document may have been reviewed.
CD6-329	No change made – not MHHS related.
CD6-330	Amended the clarification to state that it is a defined term.
CD6-331	No change made.
CD6-332	Added a clarification to the spreadsheet.
CD6-333	No change made – this is intentional.
CD6-334	Amended the legal text (21.2B) to make it clearer that there are timeframes.
