Accession Applications

This paper puts forward any new Accession Applications for consideration by the Panel in accordance with Clause 4 of the DCUSA.

1. ACCESSION PROCESS

- 1.1 In accordance with Clause 4 of the DCUSA, the Panel is asked to consider the Accession Application submitted. The Panel may only reject an application if it considers that an Applicant has no reasonable prospect of satisfying the relevant conditions precedent set out in Clause 16 and/or 37 of the DCUSA.
- 1.2 If an application is accepted, the Panel is required to:
 - notify each Party and the Authority of the Applicant identity, the information that will become its Party Details, and to prepare an Accession Agreement for the Applicant; and
 - make a recommendation to the Board that, upon receipt of the Accession Agreement duly executed by the Applicant, it executes the Accession Agreement on behalf of all Parties.

2. ACCESSION APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

- 2.1 The Secretariat notes that between the previous Panel meeting and the drafting of this paper, five new Accession Applications have been received.

- 2.2 The Secretariat noted that Elexon have provided assurances that the provided MPIDs are correct, and those not yet in MDD have been reserved.
- 2.3 The Secretariat further notes that the REC Code Manager have provided the following assurances regarding the following SIP applications:
 - Charged Electric Vehicles Limited (t/a ChargedEV): 'I...confirm that ChargedEV's application to become a Safe Isolation Provider has been approved by the REC; this means that REC are happy for BSC to progress any requests from the applicant to add their MPID

to MDD under Role Code 'Y'.

- Smart Choice Metering Limited: 'Smart Choice Metering are Qualified as a MOA (and EMO). I don't believe we've received an application from them yet to become a SIP, but the requirements to become a MOA is a much higher bar than a SIP, therefore we can place a lot of reliance on the fact they're currently operating as a MOA and it will be a short application process'
- Voltari Services Ltd: 'Voltari Services are currently in the late stages of completing the Market Entry to be a MOA (and EMO). Given the points above on MOA/SIP. I'd also consider them to be at the late stage of the REC Qualification process to become a SIP'

3. RECOMENDATIONS

3.1 For the above Accession Application, the DCUSA Panel is invited to:

- **CONSIDER** the Accession Application;
- **INSTRUCT** the Panel Secretary to notify each Party and the Authority of the Applicant's identity and the information which will form the Party details;
- **INSTRUCT** the Panel Secretary to prepare an Accession Agreement for the Applicant; and
- **RECOMMEND** that the Board executes the Accession Agreement on behalf of all Parties.
