## 1. Administration

### Recording

- 1.1 The Chair asked members if they were comfortable for this Working Group to be recorded. No members objected to this request. The purpose of this recording is purely to aid the Technical Secretariat in producing an accurate report of the meeting.

### Apologies

- 1.2 No apologies were received ahead of the meeting.

### Competition Law Guidance and Terms of Reference

- 1.3 The Working Group reviewed the “Competition Law Guidance” and “Terms of Reference”. All Working Group members agreed to be bound by the Competition Law Guidance for the duration of the meeting and agreed to the Terms of Reference.

### Minutes of the previous Meeting & Action Log

- 1.4 The group agreed to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with no amendments.

## 2. Purpose of the Meeting

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2.1 The Chair advised that the purpose of the meeting was to review the DCP 444 draft consultation document and to consider the next steps.

## 3. Review Draft Consultation Document

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3.1 The Chair presented the Draft Consultation Document to the Working Group and advised that CB had provided feedback ahead of the meeting.

3.2 A summary of the Working Groups agreed amendments are as follows. A version of the consultation showing all agreed changes is included as Attachment 1.

- Title – the Working Group agreed not to amend the title of the change as this would need to be returned to the DCUSA Panel.
- Timetable – ‘Authority Decision’ removed as DCP 444 is a Part 2 matter, and implementation amended to ‘In line with the MHHS Programme milestone, M8 ‘Code changes delivered’’ as agreed further in discussions.
- Section 1.2 – ‘assumed’ amended to ‘were designed against the MHHS Programme code artifact which at the time indicated’ to add clarity.
- Section 1.2 – amended to clarify that REP-002/A/B is received from Market-wide Data Service (MDS) but REP-901 is created by DNOs.
- Section 1.4 – Working Group agreed to remove this as it is not relevant.
- Section 1.6 – members agreed to add ‘(REP-002/A/B)’ to add clarity.
- Section 1.7 - option 4 amended to ‘Do not process the REP-002/A/B and raise a BSC change to stop the II REP-002/A/B message being sent’.
- Section 4.3 – last sentence updated to read ‘They also stated that billing the II run would ensure consistency with forecasting.’
- Section 4.4 – removed.
- New Section 4.4 added – members agreed to add following regarding DR runs ‘DR runs (non-scheduled interim dispute runs) were included in the artefact because they existed prior to the MHHS programme, however they have never been used in super customer billing and are not expected to be used for aggregated billing and Elexon have stated that they do not expect these to be sent.’
- Question 4 – updated to read ‘Do you see value in receiving the II data in the REP-002/A/B for forecasting purposes? Question 4a: If so, should it also be billed for consistency?’

- Question 5 added – If a BSC Change Proposal is raised to remove the II run, should the DR run also be removed?
- Section 5.2 – amended to clarify that this is the Proposer’s opinion rather than that of the Working Group.
- Section 6 – updated for clarity.
- Question 8 added – ‘how are you impacted by the outcome of this CP?’
- Section 7 – Working Group agreed to amend the implementation date of the CP to align with DCP 445<sup>1</sup>. ‘The Implementation Date for this Change Proposal will be the date determined by the Authority in line with the MHHS Programme milestone, M8 ‘Code changes delivered’

## 4. Next Steps & Work Plan

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- 4.1 The Chair agreed to circulate the tracked version of the document to members following the meeting and asked for further feedback by the end of the day.
- 4.2 The Working Group agreed for the consultation to be issued on 08 October 2024 for a period of two weeks. Responses will be due on 22 October 2024.
- 4.3 The Working Group will meet again on 25 October 2024 at 1pm to review the consultation responses.

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- 5.1 No other business was raised.
