### 1. Administration

#### Recording

- 1.1 The Chair asked members if they were comfortable for this Working Group to be recorded. No members objected to this request. The purpose of this recording is purely to aid the Technical Secretariat in producing an accurate report of the meeting. The recording will be deleted once these minutes have been approved.

## Competition Law Guidance and Terms of Reference

- 1.2 The Working Group reviewed the “Competition Law Guidance”. All Working Group members agreed to be bound by the Competition Law Guidance for the duration of the meeting.

## 2. Purpose of the Meeting

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- 2.1 The Chair set out that the purpose of the meeting was to review the draft legal text, consider other impacts and provide an update on the DCP 420 RFI.

## 3. DCP 454 Draft Legal Text

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- 3.1 The Working Group reviewed the draft legal text. An updated version of the legal text can be found in Attachment 1. Key points from the review can be found below:

- It was agreed that Electric Vehicle Charging Sites should be defined. The following was drafted:

Electric Vehicle Charging Sites are classed as Non-Domestic Premises which are Final Demand Sites (with the exception of appropriate ancillary demand), for the sole use of charging vehicles where electricity is sold with a commercial transaction to a private user. These sites are divided into a number of groups, within Schedule 32 of the DCUSA, as follows:

- (a) Designated Properties connected at HV;
- (b) Designated Properties connected at LV, with a Maximum Import Capacity as the basis for their current Use of System Charge; and
- (c) Designated Properties connected at LV, without a Maximum Import Capacity as the basis for their current Use of System Charges.

- Delete new entry to Table 4: Aggregated Tariffs before revenue matching
- Delete new entry to Table 5: Site Specific Tariffs before revenue matching
- New entries added to Table 8 and 9.

## 4. Other impacts for consideration:

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- 4.1 It was noted that there will need to be an amendment to the CUSC, Schedule 14 (Charging Methodologies), and in particular at the sections dealing with residual charges, which contain a number of references to the treatment of Unmetered Supplies in the context of the residual. Therefore these may need to be expanded to mirror references to ‘Electric Vehicle Charging Sites’.
- 4.2 It was also noted that there will be additional tariffs created, with the need for multiple LLFCs to be created. There will also need to be changes to the CDCM model and the need to undertake some modelling work.

<b>Action 02/01</b>	Secretariat to draft a modelling specification regarding CDCM model impacts.
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- 4.3 It was noted that consideration is need as to how all of the other impacts outside of the DCUSA legal text will be implemented if this CP was approved.

<b>Action 02/02</b>	Consider creation of a plan to understand how this would all be implemented if approved.
