NOTICE OF DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRICITY
Regulation 26(2) of The Electricity Safety, Quality and Continuity Regulations 2002
("ESQCR")

Distributor 1 have previously contacted you in relation to obstructions preventing safe and sufficient access to our equipment, including the main fuse in your property. We wrote to you on 19/03/25, 29/04/25 and visited your property on XX/XX/XX. We then gave you written notice to undertake remedial works to correct the issue on XX/XX/XX.

You have failed to complete any works to resolve the problem.

As we have previously outlined and pursuant to Regulation 26(1) of ESQCR, the installation at your property is constructed, installed, protected and used or arranged for use so as to prevent, so far as is reasonably practicable, danger or interference with Distributor 1 network, in that our cut out has been blocked in behind toilet macerator.

Given your failure to complete the required remedial works, as set out in our letter dated 29/04/25, we now give you notice pursuant to Regulation 26(2) ESQCR that we will disconnect your property from the electricity network on XX/XX/XX.

Please urgently contact us on 0330 1596506 to provide proof that the remedial works have been undertaken, or to discuss this matter further to avoid disconnection on XX/XX/XX.
