Matters Arising Paper

1. Synopsis

1.1 This paper refers to any Matters Arising since the last DCUSA Meeting that the Panel should note.

2. Change Proposal presented for ex-Committee decision on Initial Assessment: DCP 458 'Amend DCP414 process'

2.1 The table Since the last Meeting, one urgent Change Proposal was raised and sent to the DCUSA Panel for ex-Committee decision on whether to be progressed to the Definition phase and for a Working Group to be set up to further refine the proposed solution.

2.2 The justification for this to be progressed as an urgent Part 2 matter was that this would allow a default capacity charge to be applied to those customers that had not agreed alternative tariffs under the migration process, as laid out under DCP 414, and because bills were due to be issued shortly there would be insufficient time to follow the standard DCUSA Change Proposal process and timeline.

2.3 The Panel received this ex-Committee Initial Assessment request on 18 July 2025, and on 22 July 2025 a quorate decision was made by the Panel to AGREE to:

- ACCEPT the referral of the CP;
- AGREE that the CP should be treated as an Urgent change;
- AGREE that DCP 458 should be treated as a Part 2 Matter;
- AGREE that DCP 458 should be progressed to the Definition phase and for a Working Group to be set up to further refine the proposed solution; and
- AGREE the progression of the CP in accordance with the timescales set out in paragraph 3.1 of the paper.

3. Recommendations

3.1 For this Matter Arising the DCUSA Panel is invited to:

- **NOTE** the progression of DCP 458 to the Definition Phase, as agreed.
