### 1. Administration

#### Recording

- 1.1 The Chair reminded members that this meeting is recorded. The purpose of this recording is purely to aid the Technical Secretariat in producing an accurate report of the meeting.

## Minutes of the previous meeting

- 1.2 No comments were raised.
- 1.3 The slides presented are included as **Attachment 1** and were updated during the meeting to summarise discussions/decisions.

## 2. Review Meeting 04 Outcomes

- 2.1 The Chair provided a short recap of the previous meeting, which can be found within the meeting slides. A full recap can be found in the minutes of the previous meetings on the [DCUSA website](#).
- 2.2 A key outcome of the previous meeting was the proposal to develop a DCUSA guidance document for DNOs to follow regarding how they publish their charging statements (e.g. a consistent approach to how the information is presented).
- 2.3 The Chair advised that they had presented this proposal to the DCUSA Board at their February meeting. The Board agreed that they were happy for the group to capture the standardisation issues within a document, however were uncomfortable with the idea of publishing formal guidance in an area that sits outside of DCUSA's direct governance. The Board had suggested that this group could capture the information and pass it on to a more appropriate group.
- 2.4 CO stated that they are part of the LC14 Statement Review Group and agreed this would be an appropriate group to pass the information to. The group agreed to discuss the content of the guidance document at the next meeting. Following that meeting the Chair will pass the information onto the LC14 Statement Review Group.

## 3. Define the MVP – Dashboard Design

- 3.1 The Chair advised that the purpose of the meeting was to agree the design of the dashboard and to decide which features should be included and excluded.
- 3.2 Members agreed that a filter for Grid Supply Point (GSP) would be necessary. With all 14 being included and the ability to select one, multiple, or all GSP regions.
- 3.3 Members agreed that a filter for Charging Year should be included, with current year and two years of future publications being a 'must have' and previous year (back to 2022) being a 'should have'.
- 3.4 Members discussed adding an 'updated since' filter, to enable users to do a monthly check for any addenda that have been published. The Chair questioned if this would be needed as the addendums usually relate to annex 6, which is not currently in scope. Members agreed that it should be included as changes may occur in the future.
- 3.5 Members considered how the 'Updated Since' filter would work and noted that it could potentially cause confusion. The Chair suggested that a date can be added into the table to show when it was last updated, however that the filter would need more consideration.

- 3.6 The Chair suggested to pause discussion on the 'updated since' filter for now and to revisit it later on.
- 3.7 Members agreed that a 'Tariff Name' filter should be included, with all 32 tariffs (demand and generation).
- 3.8 Members discussed the possibility of including Profile Class, however agreed not to as these are due to be removed shortly due to Market Wide.
- 3.9 Members discussed the possibility of including Measurement Class instead. One member highlighted that measurement classes sit within tariff names and therefore questioned how much value it would add. Another member noted it does not appear on the charging statement. Members agreed that this item also needed further consideration.
- 3.10 Members agreed that an 'LDNO' filter should be included.
- 3.11 Members discussed whether viewing multiple charging years at once would be a possibility for the MVP. The Chair highlighted that a complicated MVP would take a long time to build and test as opposed to a more basic MVP that can be produced quickly and can then be built upon.
- 3.12 One member raised concerns that once the basic MVP has been implemented and the subgroup has closed, whether the subsequent phases will lose momentum and not include the features that the group want.
- 3.13 The Chair noted that they would refer this to the development team who would be able to provide an estimate of time/cost. The Chair highlighted that if the MVP is too complex and expensive it is unlikely to be signed off by the Board. However a phased approach allows spreading the cost.
- 3.14 Members agreed to include 'Charge Type' and 'Time Bands'.
- 3.15 Several members noted they would like the table to reflect the charging statement. Members acknowledged that columns would be needed for any item included as a filter.
- 3.16 A summary of the features discussed is included below. The items in blue require further discussion/development.
