1. Administration

Recording

2. Purpose of the Meeting

- 2.1. The Chair explained that the purpose of this meeting is to review the draft Change Report and draft legal text within the Working Group.

3. Review of DCP 466 Legal Text

- 3.1. The Working Group reviewed the updated legal text, which had been returned by legal advisers. These changes were largely focused on improving clarity, particularly around definitions and the ordering of provisions, and were considered sensible and non-material. The group agreed that the legal drafting now clearly reflects the intent of the proposal, including clearer references to the relevant sections of Schedule 32 to define which sites are in and out of scope. Subject to circulation for a final short review, the Working Group was content for the legal text to be finalised

4. Review of DCP 466 Change Report

- 4.1. The group then reviewed the draft Change Report. A number of small updates had been made following the previous meeting, including improved wording to explain that the existing process for updating Line Loss Factors (LLCs) remains unchanged, as well as clearer tables and headings.
- 4.2. An action was taken to add additional text to section 10 of the change report to expand on what the housekeeping changes are. An updated version will be circulated shortly.

5. Review of DCP 466 Impact Assessment

5.1. The working group reviewed the impact assessment. The analysis shows both site movements and high-level financial impacts. While the approach to presenting this information is supported, some members raised noted the difference in the TNUoS impact percentage against DUoS. It was noted that this figure may be driven by a small number of outliers. Given the importance of this information for the overall case, the group agreed that further validation of the underlying data should be undertaken before finalising the report.

5.2. The Secretariat took an action to look into this further.

Post Meeting Note:

5.3. The Secretariat plans to share the data at licence level and facilitate another discussion so that the impact assessment can be finalised for the change report.
