DCP 479 'Update CDCM and CIRP to reflect introduction of new passthrough licence term'

Purpose of Document:	This cover sheet presents documents for use by the appointed DCUSA consultant in the creation of new CDCM model and CIRP model for DCP 479.
Impact Assessment Specification	This request asks the appointed DCUSA consultants (CEPA/TNEI) to undertake CDCM modelling to implement the proposed DCP 479 solution, which is adding a new row to the inputs of the models to account for a new passthrough licence term introduced by Ofgem earlier this year. The proposed solution adds a new row into the passthrough block in the the following sheets: • CDCM ◦ 'General Inputs' • CIRP ◦ 'Table 1 – Detailed', 'Table 1 – Delta from previous' and 'CIRP _General inputs' The name and abbreviation of the new row should be aligned to the name and abbreviation of the row in the PCFM ("Connections Reform Costs" and "CR"). This change is expected to have no impact on the CDCM/CIRP models, beyond allowing the costs to be recorded against the correct category in the inputs.

Notes	• Earlier this year Ofgem introduced a new Connections Reform Costs passthrough item into the ED licence (Modifications to electricity distribution licence Special Conditions to enable TMO4+ connections reform Ofgem). • This has also been added into the Price Control Financial Model (PCFM) that Ofgem are currently consulting on (Proposal to modify the RIIO-2 Electricity Distribution Price Control Financial Instruments Ofgem) and

Assumptions	• This is a normal passthrough item and does not require any special treatment within the CDCM. It just needs adding into the total passthrough and total allowed revenue.

1	Within 20 Business Days after the Supplier receives a request from the Customer for an updated Model, impact assessment and/or Model documentation the Supplier will Deliver these items. For an item to be considered to have been Delivered, it must have been received by the Customer.	3 Units
2	Within 20 Business Days of Ofgem providing approval of a Change Proposal that impacts on the Models provide a baseline model(s) that incorporates all approved Change Proposals.	1 Unit
3	Within 15 Business Days after the Supplier receives a request from the Customer for additional impact assessment data it shall provide such data.	2 Units
4	Within 5 Business Days of receiving a request for technical advice, the Supplier shall provide such advice.	1 Unit
5	The Supplier will provide a suitable attendee for any Working Group meeting for which notice of the meeting was provided at least 10 Business Days before the meeting date.	1 Unit
6	Where training is requested, the Supplier shall liaise with the Customer to agree a suitable date and deliver such training.	1 Unit
7	Where requested to provide a new Model the Supplier shall provide a timetable for delivery of such Model for agreement by the Customer within 10 Business Days.	4 Units

Each Model update will count as a single service request. For example, if an updated CDCM and Annual Review Pack are requested, with impact assessment and Model documentation, this will count as 6 weighted units.

For the purposes of the above table, the EHV Distribution Charging Methodology Forward Cost Pricing and Long Run Incremental Cost Models shall count as a single Model.
