We often receive notices under the NTC. These are often for change of registered address, notices of assignment etc. Sometimes the name of the company telling us it is changing its address finds no match to any customers advised by suppliers in data flows. Sometimes a notice of assignment may be in respect of say "ABC (Location) Solar", but that may not be a match for any of the names we know solar sites in that location by, or to any of the customers advised by suppliers in data flows.
